Background

The outbreak of COVID-19 & nationwide lockdown has raised the uncertainties and impacted the enterprises. The Indian micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME) sector has shown its continued resilience towards economic uncertainties and adversities. The sector exhibits its importance in promoting sustainable and inclusive development as well as generating large-scale employment. The GDP value of India represents 2.32 percent of the world economy with the growth rate in 2021 projected at 12.55%.

In this MSMEs plays a significant role in encouraging employment and are tool for inclusive growth. They are the quintessential growth accelerators contributing to about 30% of the gross domestic product. With a vast network of 63.4 million enterprises, that includes more than half cohesively intertwined with rural economy, MSMEs contribute around 48 per cent to exports as well. Thus, MSME Sector is the backbone of national economic structure and socio-economic development of India. The sector is an important pillar strengthening and taking ahead the vision of "Aatmanirbhar Bharat'.

The MSME sector has been at the core of the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision and therefore has received many stimulants in form of policy reforms, tax benefits, schemes, and programmes.

The Government of India, through its multiple agencies, is implementing a host of schemes for the amelioration of this sector. Aimed at improving the overall SME ecosystem in the country, these schemes are targeted at credit provisioning and financial inclusion of these enterprises, skill development, quality enhancement, technological upgradation, policy support, enhanced market linkages, boosting exports, etc.
